Public Health System Improvement Grants & Technical Assistance



The Public Health & Safety Division is now accepting applications for Public Health System Improvement Grants & Technical Assistance. **All Montana local and Tribal health departments are eligible to apply for these opportunities.**

There are three options available for the Public Health System Improvement Project:

- 1. A monetary grant that will provide funding to the awardee for the completion of a community health assessment, community health improvement plan, organizational strategic plan, quality improvement plan, workforce development plan, or development of a performance management system;
- 2. A monetary grant that will provide funding for the implementation of a health improvement program (or expansion of an existing one), implementation of a health improvement priority as identified in the community health improvement plan, implementation of an organizational development objective as identified in the health department's strategic plan, or the initiation / implementation of another health department project related to PHAB accreditation (e.g. the creation of a brand strategy, etc.);
- 3. A non-monetary grant that will provide direct one-on-one mentoring and technical assistance to the awardee from a subject matter expert in projects such as building community collaboration, PHAB accreditation management, Board of Health development, and more.
